### 1) PROGRAMME 19<sup>TH</sup> – 21<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2014:

Thursday 19<sup>TH</sup> - Arrive in Zlin, Reception party including drinks + dinner

Friday 20<sup>TH</sup> - Rugby Tournament, followed by free evening

Saturday 21<sup>TH</sup> - Rugby Tournament, followed by dinner, prizes & farewell party

### 2) FORMAT OF THE EVENT:

Age of players: - All players must be 35+
Maximum teams: - Event is limited to 12 teams

Match Rules: - Standard rugby XV rules including usual veteran modifications (e.g.

unlimited substitutions, no pushing in the scrums, no kicking outside

the 22m and no lifting in the line outs)

### 3) ENTRY FEES & PAYMENT DATES:

Deposit - 100 Euros per team, to be paid by the 28<sup>TH</sup> February 2014

Final Payment - 80 Euros per person due by the 30<sup>TH</sup> April (players & non players)

Which covers:

- Thursday reception

- Saturday dinner & farewell party

- Tournament kitty, e.g. prizes, souvenirs for each participant

### 4) PROCESS OF REGISTRATION - IMPORTANT DATES

By 28<sup>TH</sup> February 14: - entry form for the team needs to be completed

- 100 Euro payment for the team (non refundable)

- information on hotel requirements, expected number of people,

required standard...etc (see below)

By 30<sup>TH</sup> April 14: - 80 Euro payment per participant (players and non players) to be paid

- Final list of names of participants

RC Zlín reserves the right to cancel a team's registration / exclude them from the tournament if this payment is not received in full by 30<sup>th</sup> April.

### 5) TO / FROM ZLÍN, CZECH REPUBLIC

Zlin is 300 km to the East of Prague and 230 km North of Vienna. Each team are expected to make their own way to Zlin and that most teams will arrive by road / bus. However for those travelling from further away, flight options include:

- a) Prague followed by train to Zlin
- b) Brno & Ostrava airports are nearest but have limited flights
- c) Vienna & Bratislava are nearer than Prague but less well connected with public transport to Zlin.

### 6) ACCOMMODATION:

Accommodation will be provided near the rugby court at different levels of quality. Price calculation will be distributed those interested in participating in the new year.

## GEORG HOLEK HISTORY OF THE TOURNAMENT



Georg (Jiri) Holek was a great rugby gentleman and our common friend. He was born in 1939 in Moravia and a great part of his life he spent in the former Czechoslovakia. He played rugby for Slavia VSZ Brno which still exists but now called RC Brno Bystrc.

He was known not only as a fair and good player but also as an exellent organizer. In 1982 living in Germany, he founded Rugby Club Konstanz. However, he never forgot his own family roots in Czechoslovakia and it was especially thanks to him that the strong links between Czech and German veteran rugby were established and developed.

He was the initiator of regular games between the German and Czech national veteran teams but his vision led him further to the idea of organising a rotating pan European veteran rugby tournament.

He spent a lot of effort implementing his dream which finally came true, and thanks to his friends, successors, as well as new participants and last but not least, thanks to his wife, Trudi – the tournament is still alive under his name – Georg Holek Cup... hence the motto:

"Oldies… deserve respect for all theyhave already achieved in rugby and for all they will still achieve"…

## **RUGBY CLUB ZLÍN**



The first promotional rugby match was played on 05.01.1930 in Zlín, between the Brno University Club and the Technicians Club. The Rugby Union in SK Bata was founded in the year 1944. The first matches were played in 1945 against ČLTK Praha, Slavia Praha and SK Meteor Říčany. The first home game and at the same time the first international matches were played in 1947 against CFR Bucharest.

Currently the senior team plays in the first League – The Old Boys Rugby Club Zlín plays in association with the Moravian Eagles. The U13 Players this season are in 3rd place in the Championship of the Czech Republic.

## ZLÍN

The city of Zlín is located on the border of three Moravian ethnographic regions - Valassko, Slovacko and Hana.

The first written mention is dated from 1322.

Until the end of the 19th century Zlín was not very different from other small centers. An important year in the development of Zlin was 1894 when Tomas Bata founded his shoe company.

After 1926 Zlín became a modern urban center. Tomas Bata invited many renowned architects (e.g. Le Corbusier) and the town was changed into an agglomeration full of functionalist architecture.

Tomas, his brother Anthony junior and their sister Anna were the founders of the Bata Shoe Company. Together they were among the greatest entrepreneurs of that time. They introduced many new ideas in the production and sale of their goods so that many future economists were affected.. Their methods and technology were revolutionary in business at that time and they are still being used as examples in top management. The "Bata" Company changed everything in the city of Zlín.
