

## **International Vets Rugby Tournament (11. Heini-Cup) in Berlin on oct. 3<sup>th</sup> 2020**

On 3<sup>th</sup> october we will organize our 11. Heini-Cup, a tournament for Rugby Veterans in Berlin. It is our goal to have this tournament posted in the national - and international Rugby calendar on a regular basis. We want all interested vets teams in two category, 40+ and platinum (50+), to participate.

Therefore, we invite you cordially to come to Berlin. The maximum number of teams in the tournament is limited to twelve. We'll charge € 150,- per participating team for the organization of the tournament.

- 10:00 o'clock: Kickoff
- 17:30 o'clock: end of tournament (depending on the number of registered rugby team)
- 18:00 o'clock: presentation ceremony
- 20:00 o'clock: Party on the pitch or in the BSV-Casino

### Team

A team consists of 12 players and 3 substitutes.

### Age of players (Category 40+ and Platinum (50+))

All players need to be 40 or 50 years (or older) at the time of the tournament.

### Playing time

All teams play against each other for 2 x 10 minutes.

### Rules

The matches in this tournament will be played according to the international oldies rules. Players over 60 years of age can wear shorts in red to identify them, players over 65 gold-colored shorts. The players in red may not be tackled during the match. Players over 65 years may not be held or tackled, they may just be stopped passively. The special rules are based on traditional 'Golden Oldies' rules and include no pushing in scrums, coloured bibs protection for players who do not want to be tackled hard (or at all), no clean outs at breakdowns and a number of variations that protect players while not decreasing the enjoyment of the games.

### Referee

Each team is asked to provide one or more referees. All referees are kindly asked to attend a short meeting at 9:30 o'clock before the start of the tournament for a short briefing by the organizer.
